SUBJECT: Federal OSHA Hazard Communication Standard

Gentlemen:

Section 1910.1200 (b) (5) (iv) of Title 29 CFR Part 1910.1200, Hazard Communication, exempts "Articles" from the labeling and Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) requirements.

Section 1910.1200 (c) defines "Article" as "a manufactured item: (i) which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture; (ii) which has end use function(s) dependent in whole or in part upon its shape or design during end use; and (iii) which does not release, or otherwise result in exposure to, a hazardous chemical under normal conditions of use."

We feel that, under this definition, products supplied to you by P-T Coupling Co. are "Articles" and therefore do not require a MSDS sheet.
